In combination with Wanakia Wildlife Rehab and Education Center of Richfield we are now able to offer educational programs that feature live rehabilitation animals from the Center. Each program is designed to help students better understand the natural world around them, while allowing them a hand on approach to capture and retain their interests. These programs make a great addition to your evening schedule, but are available throughout the day.

The *Beautiful Birds of Prey*

program stars a red tailed hawk named “Bo” and a Great Horned owl called “Merlin”, It will show the connections these animals have to the prey they seek. Learn the adaptations that allow the owl to swivel its head and track the small deer mouse rustling through the dried leaves. Visualize the hawk’s eye zooming in on its quarry from 500ft in the air.



This Reptiles program touts a variety of creatures from a Red tailed boa constrictor “Slider” weighing in at a grand 14 lbs, to a sulcata tortoise “buddy” whose shell is as tough as his personality. Students will discover the feel of smooth snake scales and understand the natural waddle walk of the tortoise.

program will feature creatures from the other two programs as well as a young friend to the center “Pete” an opossum who was given to the center after a car accident. In this program students will be able to experience a larger view of the animal inhabitants around them.
